WHAT FUNDING IS AVAILABLE?

Maximum of \$2,000 for each grant

ELIGIBLE PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Activities (including small on-ground works projects) that improve peoples' capacity to:

- Manage weeds
- Improve or rebuild facilities
- Repair or replace equipment for safe handling of livestock
- Manage livestock
- Recover from bushfire

This project will not fund activities or the purchase of livestock that have already occurred.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING?

- Individual farmers and land managers in the Tenterfield Local Government Area
- Community groups and organisations in the Tenterfield Local Government Area
- Groups of landholders (this may include producer groups, Landcare groups, neighbouring landholders working together etc.) in the Tenterfield Local Government Area
